PURPOSE

The Heartland Pride Scholarship was established in 2012. The mission of the scholarship is to provide financial assistance to individuals who identify as **LGBTQ+/Queer/Gender Nonconforming/Transgender** who are enrolled for undergraduate study in community colleges, universities and trade schools. The Scholarship principally targets two and four year academic programs.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE *is based on academic performance, leadership potential, and participation in community involvement.*

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Awards will be up to 1,000 dollars in each category

Brad Fugeli Award (17-24 adolescent category)

Marsha P. Johnson Award (24 and up)

Dino Andrade Award (an individual with disabilities seeking higher education to pursue academic goals)

CRITERIA

- Applicants must have permanent residence status in Nebraska and plan to attend a school in the state. (Iowa Western is the exception)
- Applicants must have completed all requirements to attend secondary education/trade school
- Applicants must be accepted as a full time student at a *college, university, or trade school* program for the upcoming academic year.
- Applicants must complete and submit a Scholarship Application time stamped by 11:59 March 30, 2018
- Applicants must complete a 250 word essay or 3 minute video on “How The Heartland Pride Scholarship will impact my education”.

TIMELINE

- Applications are due **April 30th, 2019**
- Applicants are notified if awarded a scholarship by June 1st, 2019

Application Process

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS MUST PROVIDE:

- Completed application form.
- Official transcript from their last attended educational institution.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- Proof of acceptance at an academic, vocational or technical school for post-secondary studies.
- A minimum 250 word essay or link to 3 min max video
- A letter of acceptance from the college or university or proof of enrollment

SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

- Award notification will be given by June 1st, 2019.
